



Certainty Versus Clarity







What's the difference between certainty and clarity?

When facing a big decision, it's essential to understand the difference between *certainty* and *clarity*. Certainty is about guaranteeing an outcome. Clarity is about the right next step. Seeking certainty leads to paralysis when it's impossible to make guarantees about the future. Seeking clarity is the recognition that our "big decision" is actually a series of choices combining the best of what we know and what we sense.
