RESPONDING *versus* FURTHERING

In critical conversations, what's the difference between responding and furthering?

Responding often leads to verbal ping-pong where each party plans their return shot as the other person speaks. It's reactive. And more about convincing than discovering. Furthering co-evolves the conversation to a destination neither party could reach alone. Rather than reacting or chasing a point into a dead end, you shift in ways that put the exchange on a more productive path.
